

Boatyard Covered Storage Terms and Conditions

Bookings and Rental Term

Bookings for covered storage must be made in advance.

A deposit equal to 50% of the total charge for the duration of the booking must be paid at the time of booking.

Changes to the booked rental term

Each day that the shed is occupied outside of the booked rental term (eg to accommodate delays to work), GHIL is entitled to charge double the normal covered storage charge. This charge will be applied if another booking is impacted as a result of the change.

If a booked rental term is shortened or cancelled, no refund will be given for the unused days unless the shed can be rented to another customer on those days. GHIL will make all reasonable efforts to re-rent the shed so that a refund may be given.

Charges

Covered storage charges will apply from the day that the boat is placed in the shed to the day it is removed and will be inclusive of these days regardless of the time that this happens on the day.

Charges include power and water.

Rules

- The renter is responsible for the safe use and cleanliness of the shed for the duration of the rental term.
- The use of silicone products in the shed is strictly prohibited. Any use of silicone products such as propeller coatings, which contaminate the shed will incur a removal cost charged to the renter.
- The shed must be fully cleaned and ready for the next vessel by 5pm the day before the final day of the rental term. A check of the shed will be carried out at this time. This means the walls and doors must be free from stains and dust and all residues must be swept or vacuumed up off the ground and disposed of in the hardstand bins. Failure to do so will incur a cleaning fee of \$500 payable prior to relaunch of vessel.
- GHIL shall assume no liability regarding loss or damage to tools, plant or vessels while stored in the shed.
- Adequate and compliant ventilation and fallout protection measures shall be used while spray painting is underway within the shed.
